

HIGH SCHOOL CONCENTRATIONS

Secondary 1, 2 & 3 students must select one concentration.

Classes are offered 5 days out of 6.



DANCE

With the introduction of our Dance Concentration, we strive to nurture the student's interest in dance and self- expression. DRAMA

Characterization, voice and movement class will lead to casting, staging, rehearsals and the show! Plays are not just about acting. Students will learn about and explore these roles as well.



MUSIC

Royal Vale offers a music program to students who are interested in learning and performing with a musical instrument.
